- 1 September** **TRUMBO (USA) 2015.** Director Jay Roach. Biography/ Drama. Stars Bryan Cranston, Diane Lane & Helen Mirren. In 1947, Dalton Trumbo was Hollywood's top screenwriter, until he and other artists were jailed and blacklisted for their political beliefs. Oscar & Golden Globe Nominee.

- 22 September** **FORCE MAJEURE (Sweden/France/Norway) 2014.** Director Ruben Ostlund. Drama. Stars Johannes Kuhnke, Lisa Loven Kongsli & Clara Wettergren. A family on holiday in the French Alps is confronted with a devastating avalanche. Golden Globe Nominee 2015 & BAFTA Nominee 2016.

- 13 October** **ARGO (USA) 2012.** Director Ben Affleck. Biography / Drama/ History. Stars Ben Affleck, Bryan Cranston & John Goodman. Acting under the cover of a Hollywood Producer scouting for a location for a science fiction film, a CIA agent launches a dangerous operation to rescue six Americans in Tehran during the U.S. hostage crisis in Iran in 1980. Winner of 3 Oscars. Member's recommendation.

- 3 November** **SCHOOL OF BABEL (France) 2013.** Director Julie Bertucelli. Documentary. Stars Maryam Aboulgila, Felipe Arellano Santibanez & Miguel Angel Cegarra Monsalve. Following the days of the special needs class at La Grange Aux Belles in Paris, welcoming foreign students from all over the world during the 2011-2012 school year and witnessing the positive spirit that prevails there under the wise guidance of Brigitte Cervoni, their inspired French teacher.

- 24 November** **THE DISCREET CHARM OF THE BOURGEOISIE (France) 1972.** Director Luis Bunuel. Comedy. Stars Fernando Rey, Delphine Seyrig & Paul Frankeur. Oscar Winner - Best Foreign Language Film 1973.

- 5 January** **EL SUR (Spain) 1983. Director Victor Enrice. Drama/Romance. Stars Omero Antonutti, Sonsoles Aranguren & Iciar Bollain.** A rural Spanish teenager with a rich imagination, dreams of her mysterious father, a man who in recent years has drifted away from her. She struggles to piece together her father's secret history and recalls her family's sudden unexplained move from Seville, Spain, to the northern countryside in her youth. Winner of 6 Film Awards & Palme D'Or Nominee 1983.

- 26 January** **HEAR MY SONG (Ireland/ UK) 1991. Director Peter Chelsom. Musical/ Comedy/ Drama. Stars Ned Beatty, Adrian Dunbar, Brian Flanagan.** The owner of a failing music club, seeks the infamous Irish singer Joseph Locke in order to bring business and success to his club. Golden Globe Nominee 1992 & BAFTA Award Nominee 1993. Winner of Best Comedy Award 1992 for Best Comedy Film.

- 16 February** **THE GRUMP (Finland/ Iceland) 2014. Director Dome Karukoski. Comedy/ Drama. Stars Antti Litja, Petra Frey, Mari Perankoski .** The Grump is an 80 year old farmer, a man of the past who knows everything used to be better in the old days. After a fall, he is forced to spend time in the city with his family much to his displeasure. Edda Award Nominee (Iceland) 2016 & Jussi Award Winner (Finland) 2015.

- 9 March** **PATHS OF GLORY (USA) 1957. Director Stanley Kubrick. Drama/ War. Stars Kirk Douglas, Ralph Meeker & Adolphe Menjou.** After refusing to attack an enemy position, a general accuses the soldiers of cowardice and their commanding officer must defend them. BAFTA Film Award Nominee 1958.  
**IMDB Score 8.5 88 mins.**
- 23 March** **SELMA (USA) 2014. Director Ava DuVernay. Biography/ Drama/ History. Stars David Oyelowo, Carmen Ejogo & Tim Roth.** A chronicle of Martin Luther King's campaign to secure equal voting rights via an epic march from Selma to Montgomery, Alabama in 1965. Oscar & Golden Globe Winner 2015. Member's recommendation.  
**IMDB Score 7.5 128 mins.**
- 20 April** **BLIND CHANCE (Poland) 1987. Director Krzysztof Kieslowski. Drama. Stars Boguslaw Linda, Tadeusz Lomnicki & Zbigniew Zapasiewicz .** Witek runs after a train. Three variations follow on how such a seemingly banal incident could influence the rest of Witek's life. Winner of 2 Polish Film Festival Awards 1987.
